

## SHAWBURY PARISH COUNCIL

### RESULTS OF THE CONSULTATION WITH MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

Over 100 questionnaires were returned and these together with the responses received at the public meeting have enabled the following information to be provided.

1. Desire for additional development:

The numbers wishing to see further development and those opposed to it were virtually the same. As a result Council Members have confirmed the request for Shawbury Parish to be recognised as a 'hub'.

2. Suggested number of properties to be constructed during the fifteen year planning period.

Of those who wished to see continued development, there was a majority (62%) indicating that this should not exceed fifty properties. This has been supported by a majority of Council Members.

3. Location of future development:

Of those wishing to see further housing 48% wished to see development contained within the current planning boundary. The most popular other suggestions were for land between St. Mary's School and Erdington Close and between White Lodge and Park House.

4. Use of levy income:

The most popular projects identified were:

Vehicle operated speed controls

Additional facilities for young people

New Sports Facilities

There is however, an urgent need to improve pedestrian access along Church Street, even more since the decision to locate the combined school on the existing site in Poynton Road and Shropshire Council needs to seek ways of meeting this need.
